"The Nine Lives of Lucky the Cat" takes place in a single location: The mind and memory of Lucky the Cat. As the action of the play is ultimately a recollection, locations are merely suggested through lighting, and properties are few. As the audience is seated, the bare stage is visible. A yellow ball is at center.

No. 1 "Overture"

House lights fade, followed by stage dimming to a single spot on a yellow ball. A growing intensity, then blackout. Lights restore almost immediately on LUCKY, a cat. He has a small suitcase in each hand. He is about to step upon the large yellow ball.

LUCKY: I found a scroll made of parchment. And on it was written: "Find Me." And it was signed: "Your Mother. Your Father. Find Me." This is where it all begins. Do I have what I need? (holding up a small suitcase in his right hand) Here are my hopes. (holding up a small suitcase in his left hand) Here are my fears. Who will catch me when I fall from the sky?

FEMALE ONE appears, as MAMA CAT.

MAMA CAT: I will.

MALE ONE appears, as PAPA CAT.

PAPA CAT: So will I.

LUCKY: All right, here I come!

LUCKY takes a step on the ball.

No. 2 "They're Coming"

The stage is alive with movement and light.

ENSEMBLE: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

HURRY NOW I'LL TELL YOU HOW

THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

HURRY NOW I'LL TELL YOU HOW THE MAMA CAT IS ALMOST THERE

MAMA CAT IS ALMOST THERE!

LUCKY rolls the ball to PAPA CAT, who ceremoniously hands the ball to MAMA CAT. LUCKY stands aside and watches all.

ENSEMBLE: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

HURRY NOW I'LL TELL YOU HOW

THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

HURRY NOW I'LL TELL YOU HOW THE MAMA CAT IS ALMOST THERE

MAMA CAT IS ALMOST THERE!

MAMA CAT lies on her side, the yellow ball at her belly. The ENSEMBLE moves close to her.

ENSEMBLE: I CAN HEAR IT IN HER VOICE

SEE IT IN HER EYES, FEEL IT IN THE AIR.

MAMA & PAPA: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING...

ENSEMBLE: I CAN HEAR IT IN HER VOICE

SEE IT IN HER EYES, FEEL IT EVERYWHERE.

MAMA & PAPA: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING...

ENSEMBLE: MAMA CAT SHE'S ALMOST THERE

MAMA CAT IS ALMOST THERE!

THE MIRACLE, MIRACLE

IT'S ABOUT TO HAPPEN, OH

THE MIRACLE, MIRACLE

IT'S ABOUT TO START, YOU KNOW

THE MAMA CAT, MAMA CAT

FEMALE 1: WHAT KIND OF MIRACLE IS THAT?

ENSEMBLE: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

FEMALE 2: MUST YOU REALLY CRY IT NOW?

ENSEMBLE: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

FEMALE 2: SHE WANTS IT VERY QUIET NOW!

ENSEMBLE: THE MAMA CAT!

FEMALE 2: SHHH!

ENSEMBLE: MAMA CAT! FEMALE 2: SHH! SHH! ENSEMBLE: MAMA CAT!

FEMALE 2: SHHH!

ENSEMBLE: MAMA CAT...

MAMA CAT IS ALMOST THERE!

THE MAMA CAT IS ALMOST WHERE?

FEMALE 1: WHERE IS TOM?

LIGHT appears on PAPA CAT, asleep to one side.

FEMALE 2: TOM'S OVER THERE, WELL FED

AND NOW HE'S SLEEPING IN THE CLOVER.

LUCKY crosses to PAPA CAT, smiling and remembering.

FEMALE 1&2: THAT TERRIBLE TOM.

TOM DOESN'T CARE. HE SAID ...

PAPA CAT: (stretching and yawning)

WAKE ME WHEN IT'S OVER.

QUARTET: JUST LIKE A MAN—JUST LIKE A MAN

JUST LIKE A MAN—JUST LIKE A MAN

JUST LIKE A—JUST LIKE A MAN!

PAPA CAT crosses to MAMA CAT.

PAPA CAT: IN NINE WEEKS TIME SHE'S GROWN SO ROUND

SHE SLEEPS AND PURRS AND CURLS UP TIGHT IN A CORNER OF THE HOUSE SHE HAS FOUND

A QUIET PLACE, A WARM DARK SPACE

TO AWAIT THE HAPPY SOUND

PAPA CAT nuzzles MAMA CAT tenderly, comforting her.

QUARTET: OF NEW LIFE

PAPA CAT: NOW SHE'S BREATHING RATHER FUNNY

QUARTET: NEW LIFE

PAPA CAT: AND SHE'S PURRING VERY STRANGE

QUARTET: NEW LIFE

PAPA CAT: SHE'S AWAITING THEIR ARRIVAL

WHILE DREAMING OF THEIR NAMES!

MAMA CAT stands, legs apart, lifting the ball high above her. One by one, FIVE KITTENS crawl out from between her legs as PAPA CAT nudges each encouragingly. LUCKY, no longer an observer, is the last to emerge. Seeing light for the first time, the FIVE KITTENS (LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN and GUS) open their eyes and cling to each other as they are enveloped in the arms of MAMA CAT and PAPA CAT.

ENSEMBLE: THEY'RE HERE! KITTENS!

THEY'RE HERE! KITTENS!

QUARTET: THEY'RE COMING, THEY'RE COMING

HURRY NOW I'LL TELL YOU HOW

THEY'RE COMING THEY'RE COMING HURRY NOW I'LL TELL YOU HOW

ENSEMBLE: THE KITTENS ARE FINALLY HERE!

Blackout.

No. 3. "Where Am I?"

Lights restore on LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN and GUS curled up at center. MAMA CAT and PAPA CAT withdraw. Each in his turn, the FIVE KITTENS awake, stretch and look about. LUCKY, alone, takes a step forward.

LUCKY: NOW WHAT?

LIFE'S BEGUN THIS IS WHERE

I'M STARTING FROM

NOW WHAT?

THIS IS MY FIRST DAY.

SO MUCH YET TO LEARN

ALL I WANNA DO IS FIND MY WAY

WHERE AM I? WHEN DID I? WHAT AM I DOING HERE?

LILLY & FRAN: WHERE AM I?

LUCKY: WHY?

LILLY & FRAN: WHEN DID I?

ALL THREE: WHO ARE YOU?

IT'S ALL SO NEW.

GUS & JACK: WHERE AM I? WHEN DID I?

LUCKY, LILLY,

& FRAN: HOW DID I GET HERE AND WHY?

GUS, & JACK: WHAT AM I DOING HERE?

LUCKY: WHERE AM I?

GUS & JACK: WHY?

LILLY & FRAN: WHEN DID I? FIVE KITTENS: WHO ARE YOU?

IT'S ALL SO NEW.

No. 4 "This Is Your Beginning"

MAMA CAT and PAPA CAT turn toward FIVE KITTENS, who are now facing upstage. MAMA CAT moves toward them.

MAMA CAT: THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING

THIS IS WHERE YOU START THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING

ON THE JOURNEY OF YOUR HEART

THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING

TAKE A LOOK AROUND

AT ALL THE WONDERS TO BE FOUND

TAKE IN EVERY FEELING

EVERY SIGHT AND EVERY SOUND

AS YOU GO ON

AS LIFE GOES ON

PAPA CAT approaches FIVE KITTENS.

PAPA CAT: THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING

THIS IS WHERE YOU START

THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING
THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING
YOU'RE A WORK OF ART
AND YOU'RE JUST BEGINNING!

TREES ARE THERE TO CLIMB
AND EVERY LEAP IS YOURS TO MAKE
SHOULD YOU STUMBLE DON'T GIVE UP
BUT LEARN FROM YOUR MISTAKE

MAMA CAT: THERE'S SO MUCH TO SEE
PAPA CAT: THERE'S SO MUCH TO DO
MAMA CAT: THERE'S SO MUCH TO BE
BOTH: SO MUCH TO GO THROUGH

AS YOU GO ON. AS LIFE GOES ON.

THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING
COME AND HOLD MY HAND
I AM HERE TO GUIDE YOU
THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING
AND UNTIL YOU LEARN TO STAND

AND UNTIL YOU LEARN TO STAND

I'LL BE RIGHT BESIDE YOU

NOW GO ON. LIFE GOES ON.

LAUGH BY LAUGH AND TEAR BY TEAR AND JOY BY JOY AND FEAR BY FEAR AND DREAM BY TRUTH BY HOPE BY CARE BY WISH BY PRAYER

THE SUN WILL BURN

YOU'LL BE FINE NOW GO ON!

FIVE KITTENS: THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING

THIS IS WHERE YOU START THIS IS YOUR BEGINNING!

A light isolates LUCKY.

LUCKY: Now what?

Blackout.

No. 5 "The Five of Us"

Lights up on LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN and GUS, with yellow ball.

FIVE KITTENS: THERE'S ONLY ONE THING

FOR A KITTEN TO DO

ON A DAY LIKE TODAY THAT'S PLAY!

The FIVE KITTENS run about the stage, throwing the ball to each other in a game of catch. GUS catches the ball, stops, and points to an unseen tree.

GUS: THERE'S A TREE OVER THERE

WITH BRANCHES HANGING DOWN

WAITING FOR ME TO CLIMB!

GUS tosses the ball to FRAN. Throughout the following, LUCKY follows the others, tentative and cautious.

FRAN: THERE'S A SPOOL OF WOOL

YELLOW, GREEN AND BROWN WAITING FOR ME TO UNWIND!

FRAN tosses the ball to JACK.

JACK: OH, MY IS THAT A MOUSE

SCURRYING ALONG

THAT I COULD CHASE AFTER?

LILLY ANN: IS THAT A MOUSE?

HURRYING ALONG?

THAT I CAN RUN FASTER THAN!

FRAN & LILLY: OH, MISTER MOUSE WOULD YOU LIKE

TO STAY AND PLAY WITH ME?

FIVE KITTENS begin a simple dance, passing the ball from each to each. LUCKY has trouble keeping up.

FIVE KITTENS: WON'TCHA COME SAY HELLO

AND PLAY WITH US

LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN AND GUS

US KITTENS

WON'TCHA COME SAY HELLO

AND PLAY WITH US

LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN AND GUS

US KITTENS?

OH, I SEE. HE GOT SCARED AND RAN AWAY FROM ME.

A dog barks.

GUS: WHAT IS THAT SOUND?

FRAN: WHAT IS THAT SOUND?

FIVE KITTENS: WHAT IS THAT SOUND?

IS THAT A DOG BARKING?

DO I NEED TO RUN AWAY,

OR CAN I STAY AND PLAY?

GUS, with ball under his arm, bravely steps forward and addresses the unseen dog.

GUS: HELLO, MISTER DOGGIE

MY NAME IS GUS.

THERE IS SOMETHING IMPORTANT

I'D LIKE TO DISCUSS.

IT'S ABOUT THIS FENCE AROUND YOUR YARD.

FIVE KITTENS: MAY WE COME IN?

WE WANNA RUN AND JUMP AND CLIMB

WE WANNA RUN AND JUMP AND CLIMB

WITHOUT A FEAR!

More barking.

GUS: I'M SORRY MISTER DOG

SAY THAT AGAIN.

I'M SORRY MISTER DOGGIE

I DON'T UNDERSTAND

FIVE KITTENS: WE DON'T SPEAK THE SAME WAY

WE DON'T SPEAK THE SAME WAY

AT ALL!

GUS: MAYBE WE CAN COME THROUGH YOUR FENCE

AND THEN WE CAN RUN AND JUMP AND CLIMB

LILLY & FRAN: WE CAN RUN AND JUMP AND CLIMB JACK & LUCKY: WE CAN RUN AND JUMP AND CLIMB

FIVE KITTENS: ALL DAY TOGETHER AS FRIENDS

AND THEN, OH NO...

Barking.

GUS: I'M SORRY MISTER DOGGIE

HE'S NOT SOMEONE WHO WANTS TO PLAY WITH US!

GUS places yellow ball DL. LILLY ANN looks up, thrilled.

LILLY ANN: I SEE A BIRD IN A TREE!

LILLY & FRAN: A BIRD IN A TREE

FIVE KITTENS: OH, MISTER BIRD PLEASE PLAY WITH ME!

As earlier, FIVE KITTENS begin a simple dance. LUCKY is mesmerized by the bird throughout.

WON'TCHA COME SAY HELLO

AND PLAY WITH US

LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN AND GUS

US KITTENS

WON'TCHA COME SAY HELLO

AND PLAY WITH US

LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN AND GUS

US KITTENS?

WON'TCHA COME ON DOWN AND PLAY OH WON'TCHA COME ON DOWN AND PLAY PLEASE DON'T FLY AWAY OH BIRDIE COME ON DOWN AND HE FLEW AWAY!

LILLY ANN, FRAN, JACK and GUS slow to a freeze. LUCKY crosses DL, drawn to the bird who has landed on the yellow ball. As LUCKY cautiously approaches, the bird flies to a tree limb, high above. LUCKY kneels next to the ball, looking up in wonder.

LUCKY: LITTLE BIRDIE WAY UP THERE,

DO YOU TRAVEL VERY FAR?

DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOU'RE GOING?

LITTLE FRIEND UP IN THE AIR!

I WONDER WHO YOU ARE

ARE YOU OLD OR ARE YOU STILL GROWING?

THE WORLD MUST SEEM TO BE SO MUCH BIGGER THAN YOU 'CAUSE IT SEEMS SO MUCH BIGGER THAN ME

IS THAT WHY YOU FLY ON THE BREEZE? AND REST IN A NEST HIGH IN THE TREES? IS IT TO FEEL A LITTLE BIGGER— A LITTLE LESS FRIGHTENED?

LUCKY slowly lifts the ball above his head, arms outstretched, toward the bird.

LITTLE BIRDIE TELL ME PLEASE.

Lights restore, LUCKY tosses the ball to the others, and joins their play.

LILLY, JACK, FRAN & GUS:

LOOKS LIKE IT'S JUS' THE FIVE OF US LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN AND GUS, US KITTENS.

WHO'S GONNA COME AND PLAY WITH US? LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN AND GUS US KITTENS!

IF THE MOUSE WOULDN'T PLAY AND THEN THE DOG MADE A FUSS AND THEN THE BIRD FLEW AWAY WHO'S GONNA PLAY WITH US?

LUCKY, again in possession of the yellow ball, runs back to the tree spotted earlier.

LUCKY: THERE'S A TREE OVER THERE
WITH BRANCHES HANGING DOWN!

Blackout.

School bells rings. Lights up on TEACHER. LILLY ANN, LUCKY, JACK, FRAN and GUS sit on the floor, as students, with their backs to the audience.

TEACHER: All right, class. Vocabulary time! I will say the word, and you will spell and define it for the class. Does everyone understand? KITTENS: (standing and facing audience) Yes, Miss Kittatinny.

No. 06 "Vocabulary"

TEACHER: The first word is "catalyst." Anyone? Raise your hand. Yes?
